Dear Members,

Felpham Youth Regatta is coming soon! The dates are **24th – 27th July** inclusive and the **sunshine** has been booked!!

Plans are now in hand to provide an exciting four days for our cadet members.

There are several ways the youngsters can join in:

- ❖ **Group 1** : Youth sail training (RYA stages 1-4)
- ❖ **Group 2** : Seamanship and spinnaker Advanced Sail Training
- ❖ **Group 3** : Cadet Cup – 8 races over four days for the cup + Race Training

Group 1: The Youth Sail Training is aimed at those who are ten years or older and who wish to learn to sail or to improve on the stage already achieved. Children aged 8 or 9 years **may** be accepted on an exceptional basis depending on current level of club involvement and confidence demonstrated during the season so far. Parents of 8 or 9 year olds **MUST** stay at the club whilst children are on the water.

Group 2: The Seamanship and Spinnaker Advanced Sail training is aimed at those who have already achieved RYA stage 4 and are looking for new challenges but do not yet wish to participate in the Cadet Cup. This group will engage in a range of activities including Spinnaker training, start to race training, turbo racing, seamanship skills etc. An RYA certificate may not be achieved during the course, but elements will be signed up in log books. The programme will be highly weather dependent and will also be subject to change at short notice.

Training boats will be provided for groups 1 and 2, however, those wishing to participate in Groups 1 and 2 who have their own dinghy, please write this on the application form. This may permit an increase in group numbers so it is very important that we know if you are able to use your own boat.

Group 3: The premier event of the Felpham Youth Open Regatta is the Cadet Cup. It is open to cadet members all competing for the silverware! It offers a great opportunity to prepare for the West Sussex Schools Regatta in September. In addition to the racing, there will be Race Coaching each morning with **Andy Kerr**, an RYA coach. Half of each day will be race training and half will be racing for the Cadet Cup. The maximum age for participation is those who were under 18 on January 1st 2019.

PLEASE NOTE: Own boats must be used – there may be a limited number of club Teras available to racers on a first come first served basis if the training group numbers allow.

The fees for participation in FYR are as follows:

Group 1 and 2 (Training) - £149 per person

Group 3 (Racing and race coaching) - £99 per person

Group 4 (Some of the Cadets may be asked to help with the tuition in the morning and Race in the afternoon, if this is the case the charge is £49 per person, see Callum for further details.)

If you would prefer to solely be part of the instructor team please contact Roger Belton.

Each day starts early (with bacon baps for sale!) All participants are expected to be signed on by 9am, for a 9.30am start. Finishing time will be approximately 4.30pm. All cadets must be signed out at the end of the day. Price includes a 2 course cooked meal at lunchtime each day and plenty to drink. In the event of bad weather, an alternative programme will be in action. However, there may be a need to finish early.

On Saturday, 27TH July at 6pm, there will be the FYR Prize giving event at which every child will receive their awards and certificates. Following prize giving there will be a "Thank You" supper of fish and chips for our volunteer army kindly sponsored again by Steve Pearce of Coastline Driving School.

FYR is a major event requiring significant organisation and planning. It is only achievable through the participation and goodwill of the children's parents and members of the club. **PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT IN THIS EVENT IS REQUIRED AND EXPECTED FOR THE WHOLE OF THE REGATTA PARTICULARLY WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY AND FRIDAY.** There are lots of ways to help – on the water, on the beach, in the clubhouse, first aid, sign-on/out, kitchen, bbq, helper's supper etc.!! Please do not feel that you have nothing to offer due to lack of sailing experience! We will ensure that everyone has a role suitable for their confidence and experience. It is a giant team effort!

VTO – short for "volunteer time off" and is when companies offer paid days off for employees to volunteer their time for a non-profit cause. A couple of parent helpers were able to utilise this last year by speaking to their HR departments.

FYR is an opportunity for young people to progress in their sailing skill in a structured environment that conforms to RYA standards, whilst at the same time having fun. Maintaining safe operations and adhering to RYA guidance means places are **STRICTLY LIMITED** so a speedy response is needed, **particularly for groups 1 and 2.** For training purposes, there are strict ratios for teacher/pupils and we have a limited number of boats available. Applications will be allocated primarily in order of receipt but priority will be given to those cadets who have attended the Friday night sessions regularly and depending on availability left in the particular training groups. We have over 90 cadets registered for Friday night sailing, and only limited training spaces, it is inevitable that some children and parents will be disappointed. Can all applications, **including racers**, please be returned by **SUNDAY, 30TH JUNE** as there is a lot of logistical planning to do!
